We would like to know your priorities - where do you think future care home research could make the biggest difference? What questions do you think researchers should answer about living or working in a care home?

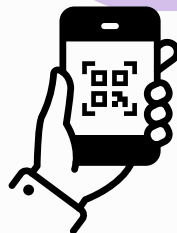
